What an incredible end to the year. 125 Christmas Hampers were distributed throughout our community with loads of toys blessing our young families. Through your generosity, each hamper had a \$20 gift card included to purchase those extra food items for Christmas celebrations.











We welcomed so many new community groups and businesses as well as connecting with our long-standing donor family members, who together make our Christmas Relief Program such a successful and heart felt experience for the recipients and everyone involved.

The lead up to the festive season was huge, beginning with our relocation back to Edward Street post flood, then straight into organising our new process of Christmas Hamper/Toy distribution with the team at the Baptist Care's Narralling Community Centre. We are incredibly grateful for this support.







We also had two fundraising events, both at the historic Denbigh Property Cobbitty. First was the Garden Open Weekend where over 500 people from all over Sydney visited these historic gardens and had the opportunity to purchase and see demonstrations from the Macarthur Ceramics Group and the Denbigh Studio, plus local wood turners and stone masons. Proceeds raised through gate entry were used to purchase food supplies for our Crisis Food Pantry. This was followed by Opera In The Barn where 200 music enthusiasts enjoyed a perfect evening of world class entertainment from Australian Opera singers, local vocalists, musicians and our own Cobbitty Community Choir led by Jodie McGuren. It was an incredible team effort and an annual event definitely missed during Covid-19. Sincere thanks to the McIntosh Family, Camden Hire, Cobbitty RFS, Cobbitty Public School and all the Turning Point team. Proceeds raised will go toward our goal for the purchase of a minibus, so we can offer further support to people in the community.
